ITEM(S) REQUIRED	DESCRIPTION
UNDERGARMENTS/MISCELLANEOUS	
14 pair underwear	Must be modest, no string bikini or thong style
1 pair thermal underwear	Polypro style material
14 pair WHITE socks	Athletic socks are allowed
6 pair DRESS socks	No "toe" socks are allowed. Holiday socks may be worn during the holiday season only – they may not be worn with sandals.
2 pair pajamas	Must be modest, no tanks or sleeveless tops

1 pair basketball/aerobic sneakers	
1 pair running shoes	
1 pair work boots	No black boots or black Doc Martins
1 pair sandals	
2 pair dress shoes	Heels must be less than 2" measured on the back of the shoe. NO PLATFORM SHOES.
1 pair hiking boots	NO COMBAT BOOTS, NO COWBOY BOOTS
1 pair shower shoes	
BOTTOMS	
2 pair sweatpants	JEANS- must be straight leg or relaxed fit. NO baggy, bellbottom or hip huggers. Pants cannot be torn or frayed. NO overalls. <i>Pants that are too big in the waist will be returned.</i> Bottom of pants must measure 10 inches or less across hem when folded flat (20" circumference). Altered pants must be professionally/permanently altered.
2 pair dress pants (No "Dry Clean Only" items)	
3 pair jeans or khaki pants	
4 pair workout shorts	NO short shorts (not even to be used as swimwear), or side slits, no long, baggy hip hugging shorts. <i>INSEAM MUST BE AT LEAST 5"</i> .
4 pair walking shorts	
OUTERWEAR	
1 light jacket	NO leather or denim jackets, no trench coats or camouflage jackets. Hoods ARE allowed on light jackets and winter jackets.
1 heavy jacket	
1 rain suit	
1 sweatshirt (<i>no hoods</i>)	Must NOT portray anything concerning alcohol, drugs, sex, tobacco, fraternities or sororities, bands, violence, or any other inappropriate pictures or sayings. <i>No hooded sweatshirts allowed.</i>
3 sweaters (<i>1 wool – no hoods</i>)	Same as above.

3 dress outfits – at least 1 must be a one-piece dress	Dresses and Skirts must not be more than 2" above knee. No "slip style" skirts, NO SLEEVELESS DRESSES. Dress outfits may not contain spandex and/or lycra.
1 ONE PIECE swimsuit	
Barrettes, elastics	NO SCRUNCHIES or baby barrettes

2-3 DISPOSABLE cameras	No instamatic or self-developing
1 or 2 stuffed animals	Cannot be large, must be kept neat.
1 baseball cap	CAN be black

1 plain blanket and facecloths	No comforters, quilts, or lap blankets, no towels
1 fleece top	See "Sweatshirt" for conditions

Photos	Family members and photos taken of other students. Photos may not contain anything lewd or suggestive. Frames must NOT contain glass.

Vitamins	Multivitamin in solid tablet form (One-A-Day, Centrum), NO weight gain or weight loss supplements. NO capsules or gel caps.
Acne Medication	If prescribed by doctor and in original container. NO tinted creams, NO alcohol content.

<p>Books (Suggestions: poetry, inspirational, educational, art books, and appropriate fiction)</p>	<p>All books will be given to the library for bar coding. The librarian will then consult with student's counselors to determine if book is appropriate for student.</p>
<p>Students may wear plain, thin, gold or silver neck chain. The only thing that is allowed on the chain is a religious pendant. A plain chain may be worn. Pendant must not exceed 1-½ inches in length, width, or diameter. NO HEAVY CHAINS.</p>	
<p>Girls may wear dime sized or smaller earrings. Only 1 matching pair of earrings in the <u>bottom hole</u> of each ear allowed. No multiple earrings. BOYS MAY NOT WEAR EARRINGS.</p>

<p>ELECTRONICS: No computers, software or related equipment or accessories, NO CD players, instant or self-developing cameras, any non-disposable cameras, camcorders, radios, electric toothbrushes, fans</p>	
<p>JEWELRY: Beads, braided jewelry, rings, bracelets, anklets, pendants (except religious), baby barrettes, hairbands, scrunchies</p>	
<p>TOILETRIES (<i>approved toiletries MUST be purchased through Campus Store</i>): Lip gloss, make-up, face masques, astringent, nail polish of any type, artificial or acrylic nails, aerosols, tanning oil or lotion, baby wipes, bobby pins, cotton balls, straight razors (all razors must be electric), hair spray, curling/straightening irons, curlers, perfume, cocoa butter.</p>	
<p>CLOTHING: <i>NO DRY CLEAN ONLY ITEMS.</i> Anything that is ripped, torn, or stained, tank or sleeveless tops (not even for pajamas or athletics), pants that drag the ground, shorts below the knee, cut offs, heels over 2", platform shoes, Spandex or Lycra clothing (except for girls' bathing suits), tie dye, midriff tops, bandanas, hoods (except on authorized coats), anything with patches sewn on, "Hip-Hop" or "Urban" wear, camouflage, socks with designs, shoelaces with designs, toe socks.</p>	
<p>HEALTH: All medication must be doctor-approved and will be given to the nurse.</p>	
<p>LINEN: Comforters, quilts, lap blankets, towels, sheets, laundry bags. (we will provide all needed linens)</p>	
<p>MISCELLANEOUS: Luggage, backpacks, permanent markers, posters, "Cliff's Notes", sewing kits (counselor must keep), scissors, shoe polish (counselor may hold for students), powdered carpet freshener, FOOD OF ANY KIND, flashlights, reading lights, stamps, address books, glass of any type including mirrors, picture frames, and vases, binoculars, maps, NO MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS (dependent upon Music Teacher availability), stuffed animals with zip pockets or noise makers, pencil sharpeners, paper weights, metal paperclips, toys/figurines, metal teasing combs, metal brushes/combs</p>
