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Structured Environment



Each School and Program provides an organized and structured environment where high standards exist. Inappropriate actions and choices are confronted, given consequences, and redirected. Appropriate actions and choices are reinforced and rewarded. The Programs and Schools offer

tight supervision around the clock. Each student follows a rigorous daily schedule and a firm set of rules. A merit system is used requiring each student to earn status and privileges through a standard program using a levels system, based on positive behavior. As students advance, each level offers additional privileges motivating the student to work harder. The Program or School becomes the testing ground to ascertain each student's level of commitment toward making positive changes.

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
