Wide Association. During the TASKS seminars, teens work on specific issues such as: Accountability, honesty, integrity, trust, choices, responsibility, anger, and especially self-esteem.

While the student is completing his or her series of seminars, the parents are invited to attend Parent Seminars and Parent Support Meetings held in many locations throughout the United States. The culmination of the TASKS Program is when parents and students are invited to attend three effective Parent/Child Workshops. These are designed to assist each family in rebuilding the family unit and become the foundation for the After-Care Program.

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
