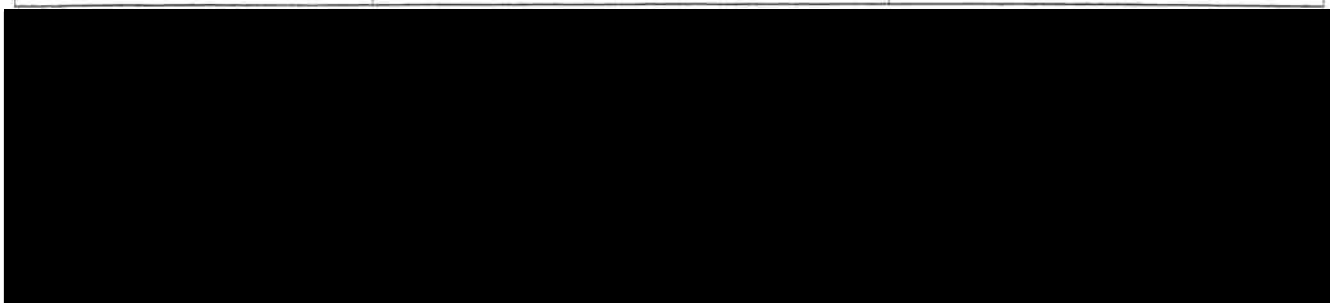

The paramedics were already there and inside the center. I ran inside and found the victim - he was in a path room on the west side of the building. He was on the floor with his head facing south. The paramedics were working on him. I asked deputy Jensen what I could be. He told me to hang on well they got vitals signs. He then told me to start CPR. I grabbed Ian's head and positioned the neck and did two rescue breaths. I noticed he was cold to the touch. Fire then came in a to take over CPR.

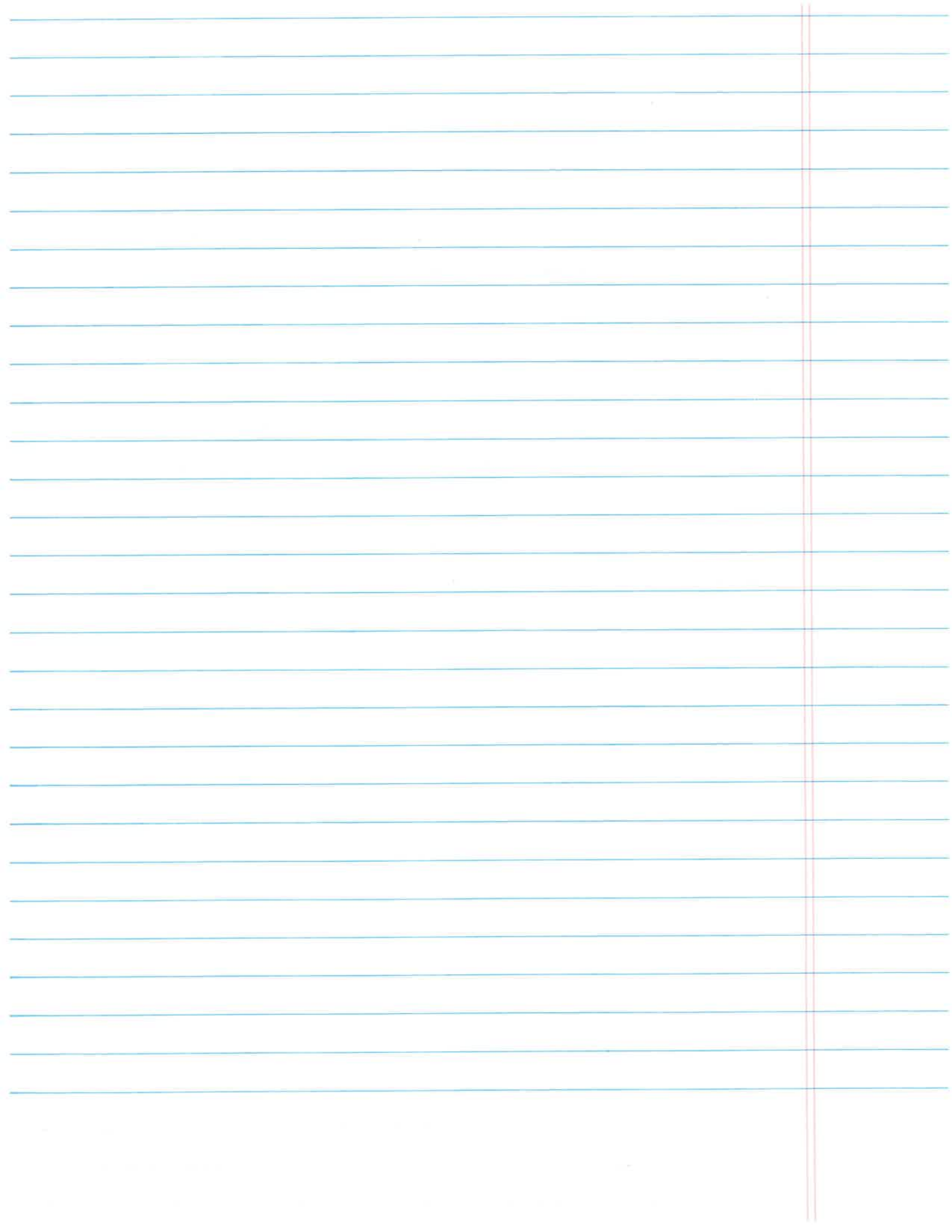

I looked in his room one more time as well as called in to the bathroom. I then asked John H. (staff) if I should go into North Side Bathroom and check to see if he was in there. I was told to look in the bathroom. When I walked in, I saw in the larger toilet stall ~~that~~ [REDACTED] feet, the front two legs of his white chair, and above the door, a belt tied to a bar and the remainder of it leading to behind the door. I banged on the door and called ~~the~~ [REDACTED] named twice, then I screamed "I [REDACTED] what the f--- KID" ~~AFTER~~ I banged on the door, but it would not open for it was locked. I then ran out into the hallway to find a staff. I saw Chris (staff) and told him that Ian was hanging himself. He ran into the bathroom and crawled under the stall. Dave (staff) ran in to the bathroom and into small toilet. Chris lifted Ian and I saw his head over the door. Afterwards, John (staff) told me to sit at my desk, and I did what I was told.

I feel that in the six years as the detective Sgt for Syracuse Police Dept., I have come to appreciate what your facility does for the many ~~your adults~~ youth you try to help save.

Please let your staff know of ~~the heart~~ our heart felt condolences and appreciation we have for them. If it was not for all of your help, our investigation could not have concluded in the timely ~~man~~ and complete manner that it did.

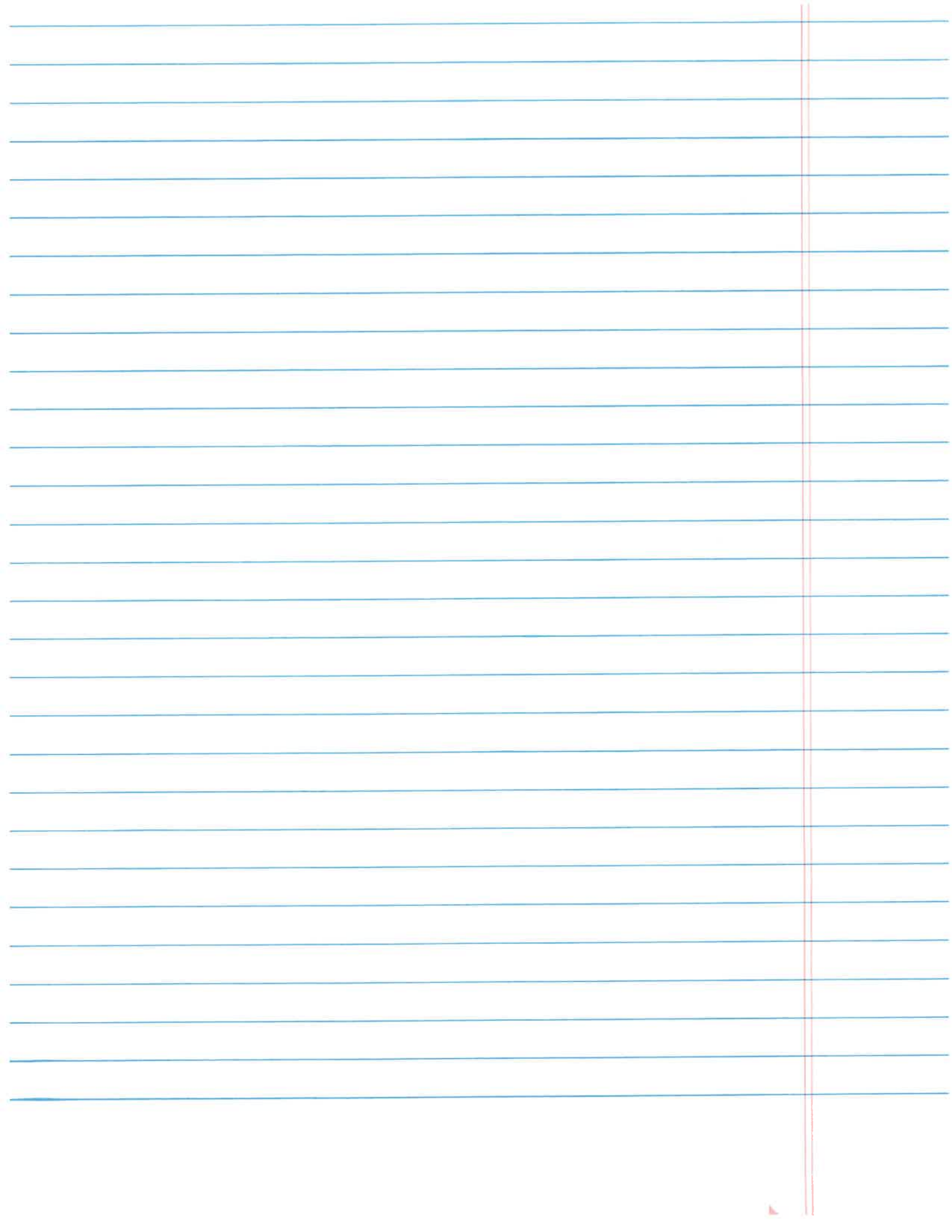
Synopsis: I was called out on July 1 2004 to respond to ~~a~~ ~~an~~ suicide attempt at Island View Treatment Center in Syracuse.

I arrived, and the 16 year old victim, [REDACTED], had already been transported to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] passed away from the suicide attempt.

I interviewed witness's, ^{student} [REDACTED] ^{staff member} [REDACTED] and Dave Ferrucci. All ~~had~~ their stories were consistent with each other.

I talked with the medical examiner's office and they confirmed the cause of death as suicide.

He escorted me into the staff area and ~~he then~~ told me the victim was on his way to the hospital. He then told me that the crime scene was to the hall to our left.

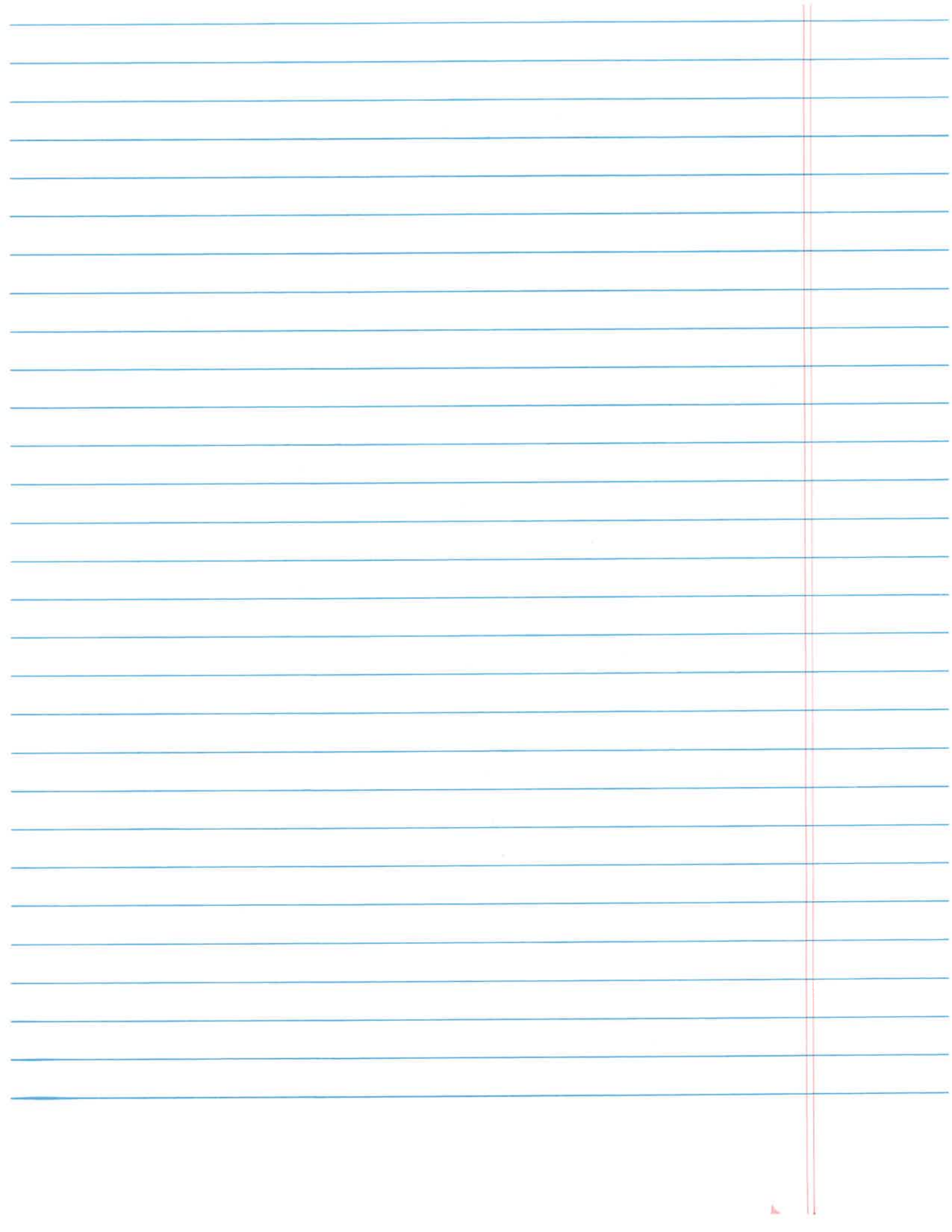
Sgt. Jensen went with me down the hall in which I observed many books, chairs and other miscellaneous items on the hall floor.

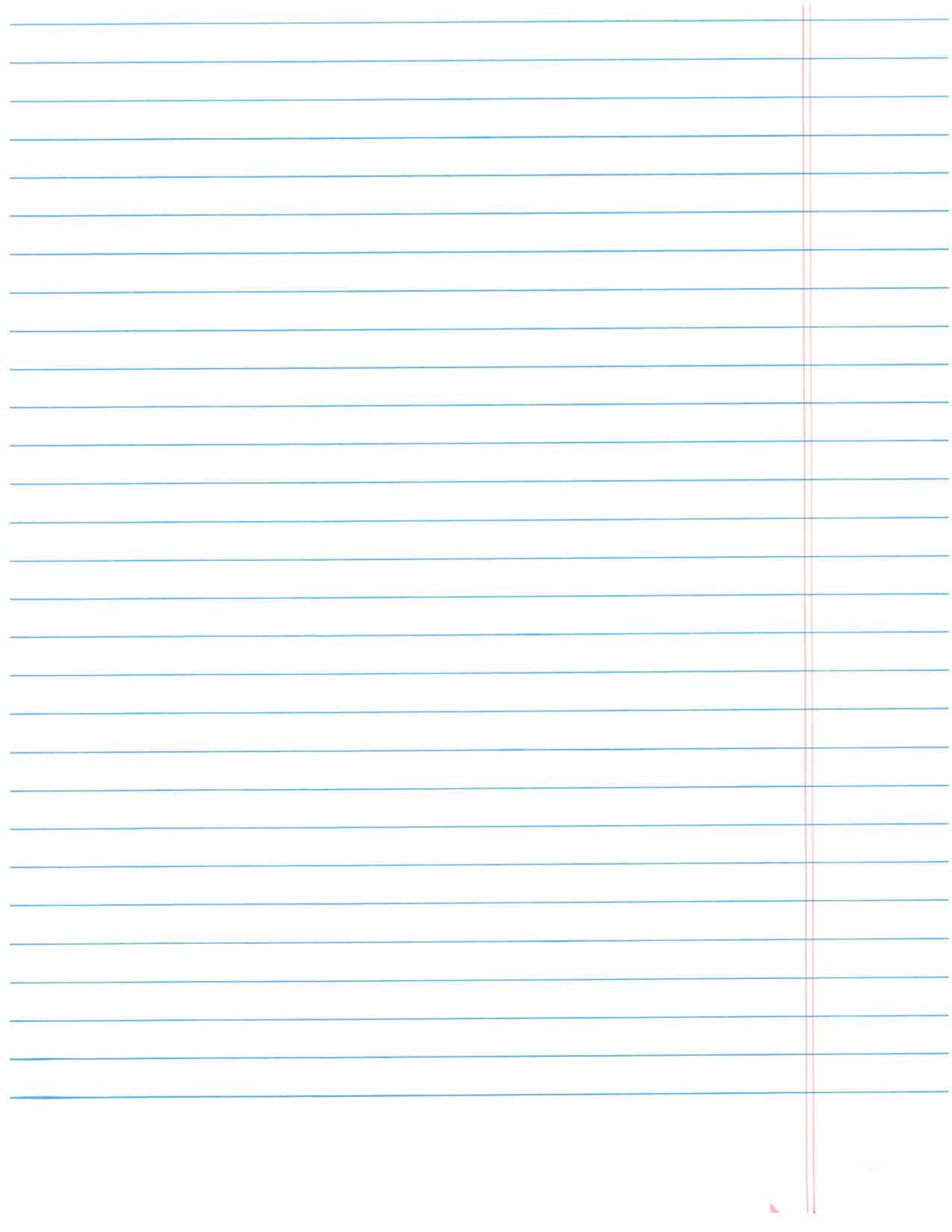

The Details are as follows:

I was called to Island View Treatment Center on a hanging.

I arrived about thirty seconds after the fire department. They were in the parking lot getting equipment. The paramedics were already there and inside the center. I ran inside and found the victim. [REDACTED] was in a bathroom on the west side of the building. [REDACTED] was on the floor with his head facing south. The Paramedics were working on [REDACTED]. I asked Deputy Jensen what I could do. Deputy Jensen told me to hold on while they got vitals signs. Deputy Jensen then told me to start CPR. I grabbed [REDACTED] head and positioned the neck and did two rescue breaths. I noticed [REDACTED] was cold to the touch. Fire then came in and took over CPR. I then had a chance to observe the scene more closely. I noticed a black leather belt hanging from the bathroom stall with a white pvc, plastic patio-style chair underneath it. I then assisted the Paramedics with some other things, including holding the IV bag. Medical personnel continued CPR for some time and administered medication. They also used a defibrillator. They then loaded [REDACTED] in the ambulance for transport to [REDACTED].

At that time Sgt. Jensen arrived. Sergeant Jensen agreed to secure the scene while I followed the ambulance to the hospital. On the way to the hospital, myself and another Deputy cleared the intersections so the ambulance could arrive quickly. Once we were at the hospital, hospital personnel rushed [REDACTED] into the emergency room. They started to work him until Dr. Holley deemed he was not viable. Dr. Holley called the time of death at 19:04 p.m.

I then contacted the medical examiner and had them come to my location. I also notified the Island View representative at the hospital. Her name was Yolanda (unknown last name.) I asked her about [REDACTED] past. She stated that he had several suicide attempts in the past and suffered from depression, however she stated that today he seemed very happy. I asked her about how he was found. She stated a staff worker found him hanging in the bathroom. The staff worker came out yelled for help. Yolanda called 911 while another staff worker went to the bathroom to help him. The two staff workers got him down and started CPR until Paramedics arrived. I asked her when was the last time he was seen and she was unsure.

I then talked to the Center's Director by phone. He wanted to know if I could come to the center to make notification by phone to the parents. I told him it was best if another agency made notification in person. I told him that Sgt. Jensen who was on scene would help him with that.

The medical examiner arrived. It was Kenny Payne, DCSO. I went ahead and gave him the information that he needed and told him to do the investigation of the body, including photographs. He told me that there would not be an autopsy performed, that there would just be an external examination, based on the circumstances. I then released the body to him and returned to Island View.

On the inside of the belt I noticed the name [REDACTED] written with permanent black marker. This would indicate that the belt belonged to [REDACTED]. I then took the belt down while Det. Rogers videotaped it and placed the belt into a bag which was given to Det. Sessions. The belt will be held in evidence.

Det. Sessions, Det. Rogers, Sgt. T. Jensen and myself all met to compare notes. Based on all of our combined information, Det. Sgt. Sessions ruled this a self inflicted suicide. I then cleared the scene.

On July 1, 2004 around 1835 hours I recieved a phone call from dispatch advising me that Corporal Rogich was en route to an echo response medical of a hanging. Prior to my arrival Corporal Rogich got a hold of me on the city channel and asked what my estimate time of arrival to the scene was. I was going to Island View Treatment Center. I was sitting at 1700 South 2000 West at a red light. He asked if I could expedite because the ambulance was getting ready to leave and transport the victim to the hospital and Corporal Rogich was going to go with them to the hospital for evidence purposes.

I responded code to the scene. As I arrived the ambulance was leaving. I immediately responded into the treatment center where I was directed to a hallway and led down the hall to a bathroom. I secured the scene by asking staff members of the treatment center to shut both doors leading into this particular hall where I stayed until Detective Sergeant Sessions arrived to process the scene.

I informed Detective Sergeant Sessions of the area in which the subject had hung himself, where I showed him a bathroom with a belt wrapped around the top bar of the bathroom stall. Detective Sergeant Sessions asked that I locate which room and which bed was [REDACTED] bed. I spoke with the staff and obtained this information. I was advised by Corporal Rogich that [REDACTED] was pronounced dead at 1904 hours.

I talked to Mr. Kimball DeLaMare and asked where the staff members were that found [REDACTED]. I was led into a conference room where there was a total of approximately 8 people sitting at a table. I asked the staff members who the two people were that found [REDACTED] and got him down. I was told that Chris Vowles and David Ferrucci were the two staff members that found [REDACTED] and got him down and started CPR on him.

I interviewed Chris and David. David told me that they went into the stall where [REDACTED] was found. [REDACTED] was hanging from the top bar of the restroom partition. The door was locked and [REDACTED] was on the inside of the bathroom stall. David told me he went into the opposite stall, which was to the south, and jumped the wall to gain access to the bathroom stall where [REDACTED] was. Chris crawled under the stall that [REDACTED] was in to gain access. Between the two of them they were able to slip the belt off of [REDACTED] neck, unlock the stall and get him down, placing him of the floor in the bathroom where they started CPR.

After interviewing these two I left them witness statements to fill out. These witness statements will be attached to my report.

Detective Sergeant Sessions and I were asked by one of the owners if we would assist them in doing a death notification. He asked our opinion on how we should do this.

It was determined that we would call Ridgewood Police Department in Ridgewood, New Jersey. I had them send an officer over to [REDACTED] parents residence and notify them of his passing.

I contacted Davis County dispatch and asked them to find a phone number for Ridgewood Police Department and see if they could have a sergeant give me a call as soon as possible.

I received a phone call from Sergeant Philip Weiler. I gave him the address of [REDACTED] parents and their names. He stated they would go over and give notification. I asked Sergeant Weiler to contact me when they were done. He agreed to do that. Approximately 25 minutes later Sergeant Weiler called me back to advise me that notification was done to the father, mother was not home. I advised Mr. Kimball DeLaMare, staff member supervisor for Island View Treatment Center, of this.

I gave Sergeant Weiler Mr. DeLaMare's cell phone number for [REDACTED] parents to call him, so they could release the details of [REDACTED] passing. Island View staff members had a conference call with [REDACTED] parents, I was not present for this phone call.

I went in and spoke with Detective Sergeant Sessions who was interviewing one of the residents that actually found [REDACTED]. We had discussed having another detective come out and help with interviews and to process the crime scene. Detective Sergeant Sessions spoke with Chief Wallace, which gave him the okay to do that. At that point Detective Sergeant Sessions called Detective Rogers out. Detective Rogers showed up on scene bringing the video camera. He went around and video taped the bathroom as well as [REDACTED] room and bed. I had Officer Johnson assist me as we went through and inventoried everything in [REDACTED] room. After we inventoried this we placed it all on his desk area. We found no papers or notes that [REDACTED] had left behind.

Detective Sergeant Sessions told me that in his conclusion to this case he believed [REDACTED] harmed himself and that nobody else was involved in assisting with that. Detective Sergeant Sessions and I met with the executive board for Island View advising them of our findings.

I interviewed witnesses, student [REDACTED] and staff member David Ferrucci. All of their stories were consistent with each other.

I talked with the medical examiner's office and they confirmed the cause of death as suicide.

NARRATIVE:

On July 1, 2004 at 1846 hours, I was called by Davis County dispatch to respond to Island View Treatment Center, 2651 West 2700 South on a report of an attempted suicide.

I arrived at the main building and was met at the front doors by Sergeant Tracy Jensen.

He escorted me into the staff area and told me the victim was on his way to the hospital. He then told me that the crime scene was to the hall to our left.

Sergeant Jensen went with me down the hall in which I observed many books, chairs, and other miscellaneous items on the hall floor.

I brought in rubber gloves and a digital camera, etc., to process the crime scene.

I first took a picture #1, which shows door to the restroom from the hall. The restroom is where I was told the incident had occurred.

I took picture #2 of the bathroom door opened, showing items used my medical staff. Picture #3 shows entering the restroom area with other medical paraphernalia used by the medical staff. Picture #4 shows inside the restroom area along with the entrance door to the bathroom from the room where [REDACTED] lived. Picture #5 shows the bathroom stalls with the belt still attached used by the victim for the suicide. Picture #6 is a closer picture of the same area but shows also the leg of the chair that was used. Picture #7 shows another shot of the same. Picture #8 shows the chair and belt in the approximate area where used. Picture #9 is a picture of the same crime scene. Picture #10 shows some shoe marks in front of the stall, what I believed were from staff member, Chris Vowles attempting to get into the stall. Picture #11 is one of the letters written by [REDACTED] about some problems he had at the school. Picture #12 is a bag of personal effects.

After taking the pictures, myself and Sergeant Jensen looked through [REDACTED] personal letters, to look for a suicide note. We were unable to find any outright suicide notes.

There were several notes which indicated his frustration with his stay at Island View.

I left Sergeant Jensen and contacted Detective Heath Rogers to respond with the video camera. When I left I went into interview [REDACTED] (aka [REDACTED]).

I asked [REDACTED] to tell me what had happened in reference to the suicide today involving [REDACTED] said that he is what Island View staff calls a, "trail boss". [REDACTED] says that he has a list of sixteen males he is in charge of making sure when they go to assemblies, meetings or meals that he is to make sure all sixteen are accounted for.

This evening nine of the individuals were to be in line to go to dinner. Those individuals were: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The other seven had their rights taken away from them and were to sit in the hall for at least 18 hours a day. They ate their meals and did their assignments while in the hall. That accounts for the other seven students, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that the nine students were in the group room watching a movie

when [REDACTED] left approximately 45 minutes earlier from the time he had been found in the bathroom by [REDACTED]

Apparently [REDACTED] had left the movie, gone into the hall where the other seven students were and took a plastic fork and was flipping it from his mouth and bothering those students.

He was told by staff member, John Holland, not to bother the students in the hall and go to his group and sit at his desk until dinner.

He was observed by those seven students and John going into his room at approximately 6:15 p.m..

There is a door from [REDACTED] room into the restroom. Apparently [REDACTED] took his white plastic chair into the restroom, took his black belt and put it around the top railing of the larger restroom stall, put it around his neck and stepped off of the chair, causing his death.

I asked [REDACTED] to go through the events of the day. [REDACTED] stated that as they were standing in line to go to dinner he noticed that [REDACTED] was missing. [REDACTED] stated that it was not unusual for [REDACTED] to be the last one in line and [REDACTED] would go to the restroom for 30 to 40 minutes at a time. [REDACTED] stated he went to the restroom, opened the door and hollered for [REDACTED], but there was no response. [REDACTED] then checked [REDACTED] room, but could not see him. [REDACTED] asked the students in the hall, where [REDACTED] was and they stated he was at his desk. [REDACTED] had just checked there and knew he was not in his room. [REDACTED] then asked John Holland (staff member), if he could go into the restroom to check for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that John authorized him to go into the restroom. [REDACTED] went into the restroom and noticed legs hanging down below the door of the restroom stall and recognized the pants as Ian's. Eddie also noticed a belt hanging down from the top rail. [REDACTED] stated he hollered at [REDACTED] and asked him, "What the fuck are you doing?" There was no response by Ian so [REDACTED] ran out into the hall and said, "The brother is trying to hang himself."

Chris Vowles (staff member), was just walking by and ran into the restroom, he was followed by, David Ferrucci (staff member). [REDACTED] stated that Chris went under the stall because the bathroom stall door was locked and David went into the smaller stall next to the one [REDACTED] was hanging from and Chris lifted [REDACTED] up while David took the belt off of [REDACTED] neck.

John Holland (staff member), came in and told [REDACTED] to go ahead and go back to his room. [REDACTED] stated he complied and went to his room.

I asked [REDACTED] how [REDACTED] had acted today. He stated that [REDACTED] had been very upbeat, which was not normal for him, but thought he was just having a good day.

I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had any problems in the past that he knew of. He stated that about a month and a half ago [REDACTED] had wrote a poem and was put on suicide watch.

[REDACTED] stated that when all the students were brought back together, [REDACTED] told everyone in the group that he felt it was his fault because [REDACTED] had used his belt.

I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had any problems with [REDACTED] being a roommate of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he knew of no problems between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had only been a roommate of [REDACTED] for approximately two days.

I then had Eddie write a witness statement.

I then had [REDACTED] brought into the room by staff members. I interviewed [REDACTED]. I asked him to tell me what had gone on today. [REDACTED] stated that he is, "On yellow zone today", this meant that he had to stay in the hall on a chair for 18 hours of the day and read books.

[REDACTED] stated that he last saw [REDACTED] in the hall around 5:45 p.m. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had stuck a plastic fork up his nose and David told [REDACTED] to go sit

at his desk. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] walked into our room and that was the last time he saw [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said he observed [REDACTED] hollering for [REDACTED] at the restroom and then asking David if he could check the north side bathroom and David told [REDACTED] to go ahead.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] went into the bathroom and came back approximately 10 seconds later and said the brother had hung himself.

David told us to go to our rooms and I went in to my room and was wondering what [REDACTED] could of hung himself with and noticed that his two belts were missing from his personal property. He described the two belts and neither matched the description of the belt I had observed.

I asked [REDACTED] "Why did you tell everybody that it was your fault that [REDACTED] had died?" He again stated, that because his belts were missing and a staff member came out of the restroom and told everyone that [REDACTED] did not have a pulse and it did not look good.

I asked [REDACTED] if he would be willing to take off his shirt so I could check for any scratches or bruises that may have been inflicted due to an altercation with [REDACTED]. I explained to [REDACTED] the necessity of this request, that it would also help clear him from any allegations since he had said that it was his fault that [REDACTED] had died.

[REDACTED] complied and there were no signs of any scratches or bruising on [REDACTED]

After concluding with this interview I met with Sergeant Jensen, Corporal Rogich and Detective Rogers in the hall. I told them that my investigation would lead me to believe that this was a self inflicted suicide. I asked if anyone else had any questions or concerns with the case and none were brought out.

I then went in to the staff area and met with Island View President, Lorin Broadbent and asked him if he would like to get his staff together so I could go over the case with them.

I met in the conference room with, Lorin Broadbent-President of Island View, Jared Balmer-Executive Director, Rick Jackson-Medical Director, Gay Jackson-Associated Executive Director, Steve Lancaster-Director of Mileu Therapy, Colleen Allie-Therapist, Dan Stuart-Director of Therapeutic Services, Dale Erdman-Therapist and Kimball DeLeMare-Director of Public Relations.

I advised them of the conclusion of my investigation and asked if there was any questions. Mr. Broadbent asked what they should do with [REDACTED] medical records that were kept in a folder? We all came up with a solution, because of HIPPA regulations that I could not review his folder without [REDACTED] parents consent. I did not want to bother [REDACTED] parents, so I went out to my patrol vehicle and I picked up a large plastic bag, put the folder inside, sealed it and gave it to Rick Jackson.

On July 2, 2004, I came back to the office and wrote an official statement with my preliminary findings and took it to Mike Moyes-City Administrator for review. I then took the letter and gave it to Lorin Broadbent at Island View.

This case is closed.

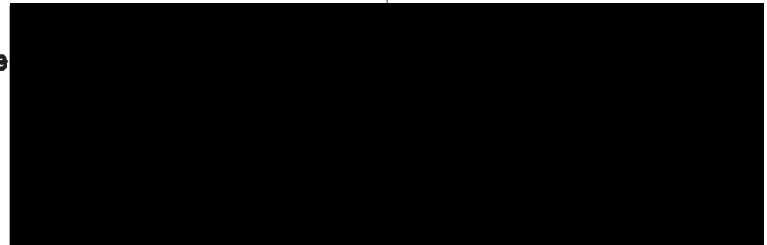

I asked Deputy Jensen what I could do. Deputy Jensen told me to hold on while they got vitals signs. Deputy Jensen then told me to start CPR. I grabbed [REDACTED] head and positioned the neck and did two rescue breaths. I noticed [REDACTED] was cold to the touch. Fire then came in and took over CPR. I then had a chance to observe the scene more closely. I noticed a black leather belt hanging from the bathroom stall with a white pvc, plastic patio-style chair underneath it. I then assisted the Paramedics with some other things, including holding the IV bag. Medical personnel continued CPR for some time and administered medication. They also used a defibrillator. They then loaded [REDACTED] in the ambulance for transport to [REDACTED].

At that time Sgt. Jensen arrived. Sergeant Jensen agreed to secure the scene while I followed the ambulance to the hospital. On the way to the hospital, myself and another Deputy cleared the intersections so the ambulance could arrive quickly. Once we were at the hospital, hospital personnel rushed [REDACTED] into the emergency room. They started to work him until Dr. Holley deemed he was not viable. Dr. Holley called the time of death at 19:04 p.m.

I then contacted the medical examiner and had them come to my location. I also notified the Island View representative at the hospital. Her name was Yolanda (unknown last name.) I asked her about [REDACTED] past. She stated that he had several suicide attempts in the past and suffered from depression, however she stated that today he seemed very happy. I asked her about how he was found. She stated a staff worker found him hanging in the bathroom. The staff worker came out yelled for help. Yolanda called 911 while another staff worker went to the bathroom to help him. The two staff workers got him down and started CPR until Paramedics arrived. I asked her when was the last time he was seen and she was unsure.

I then talked to the Center's Director by phone. He wanted to know if I could come to the center to make notification by phone to the parents. I told him it was best if another agency made notification in person. I told him that Sgt. Jensen who was on scene would help him with that.

The medical examiner arrived. It was Kenny Payne, DCSO. I went ahead and gave him the information that he needed and told him to do the investigation of the body, including photographs. He told me that there would not be an autopsy performed, that there would just be an external examination, based on the circumstances. I then released the body to him and returned to Island View.

Once at Island View I helped keep the scene secure and helped Det. Rogers with videotaping of the scene. There was a question about who the belt belonged to, so I went into the bathroom to do a closer investigation of the belt. On the inside of the belt I noticed the name [REDACTED] written with permanent black marker. This would indicate that the belt belonged to [REDACTED]. I then took the belt down while Det. Rogers videotaped it and placed the belt into a bag which was given to Det. Sessions. The belt will be held in evidence.

Det. Sessions, Det. Rogers, Sgt. T. Jensen and myself all met to compare notes. Based on all of our combined information, Det. Sgt. Sessions ruled this a self inflicted suicide. I then cleared the scene.

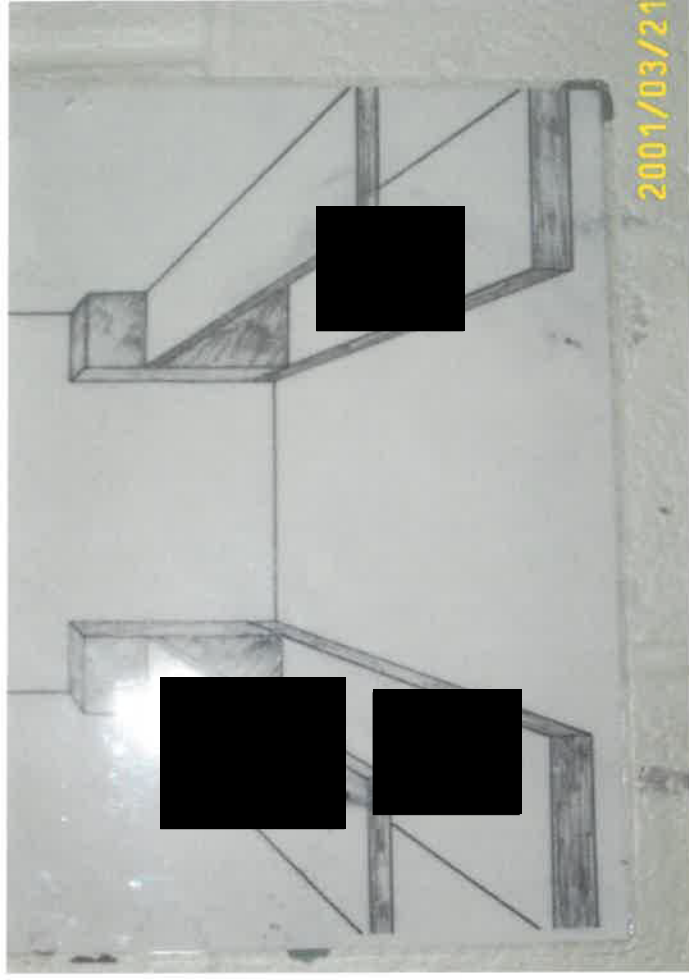

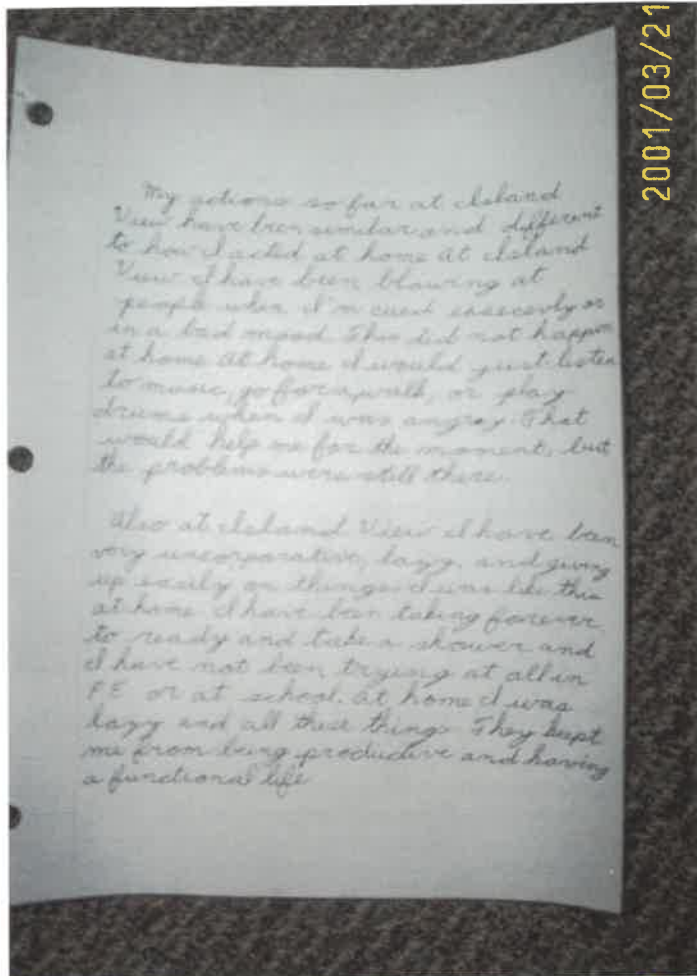

The Details are as follows:

On July 1, 2004 around 1835 hours I recieved a phone call from dispatch advising me that Corporal Rogich was en route to an echo response medical of a hanging. Prior to my arrival Corporal Rogich got a hold of me on the city channel and asked what my estimate time of arrival to the scene was. I was going to Island View Treatment Center. I was sitting at 1700 South 2000 West at a red light. He asked if I could expedite because the ambulance was getting ready to leave and transport the victim to the hospital and Corporal Rogich was going to go with them to the hospital for evidence purposes.

I responded code to the scene. As I arrived the ambulance was leaving. I immediately responded into the treatment center where I was directed to a hallway and led down the hall to a bathroom. I secured the scene by asking staff members of the treatment center to shut both doors leading into this particular hall where I stayed until Detective Sergeant Sessions arrived to process the scene.

I informed Detective Sergeant Sessions of the area in which the subject had hung himself, where I showed him a bathroom with a belt wrapped around the top bar of the bathroom stall. Detective Sergeant Sessions asked that I locate which room and which bed was [REDACTED] bed. I spoke with the staff and obtained this information. I was advised by Corporal Rogich that Ian was pronounced dead at 1904 hours.

I talked to Mr. Kimball DeLaMare and asked where the staff members were that found [REDACTED]. I was led into a conference room where there was a total of approximately 8 people sitting at a table. I asked the staff members who the two people were that found [REDACTED] and got him down. I was told that Chris Vowles and David Ferrucci were the two staff members that found [REDACTED] and got him down and started CPR on him.

I interviewed Chris and David. David told me that they went into the stall where [REDACTED] was found. [REDACTED] was hanging from the top bar of the restroom partition. The door was locked and [REDACTED] was on the inside of the bathroom stall. David told me he went into the opposite stall, which was to the south, and jumped the wall to gain access to the bathroom stall where [REDACTED] was. Chris crawled under the stall that Ian was in to gain access. Between the two of them they were able to slip the belt off of [REDACTED] neck, unlock the stall and get him down, placing him on the floor in the bathroom where they started CPR.

After interviewing these two I left them witness statements to fill out. These witness statements will be attached to my report.

Detective Sergeant Sessions and I were asked by one of the owners if we would assist them in doing a death notification. He asked our opinion on how we should do this.

It was determined that we would call Ridgewood Police Department in Ridgewood, New Jersey. I had them send an officer over to [REDACTED] parents residence and notify them of his passing.

I contacted Davis County dispatch and asked them to find a phone number for Ridgewood Police Department and see if they could have a sergeant give me a call as soon as possible.

I received a phone call from Sergeant Philip Weiler. I gave him the address of [REDACTED] parents and their names. He stated they would go over and give notification. I asked Sergeant Weiler to contact me when they were done. He agreed to do that. Approximately 25 minutes later Sergeant Weiler called me back to advise me that notification was done to the father, mother was not home. I advised Mr. Kimball DeLaMare, staff member supervisor for Island View Treatment Center, of this.

I gave Sergeant Weiler Mr. DeLaMare's cell phone number for [REDACTED] parents to call him, so they could release the details of [REDACTED] passing. Island View staff members had a conference call with [REDACTED] parents, I was not present for this phone call.

I went in and spoke with Detective Sergeant Sessions who was interviewing one of the residents that actually found [REDACTED]. We had discussed having another detective come out and help with interviews and to process the crime scene. Detective Sergeant Sessions spoke with Chief Wallace, which gave him the okay to do that. At that point Detective Sergeant Sessions called Detective Rogers out. Detective Rogers showed up on scene bringing the video camera. He went around and video taped the bathroom as well as [REDACTED] room and bed. I had Officer Johnson assist me as we went through and inventoried everything in [REDACTED] room. After we inventoried this we placed it all on his desk area. We found no papers or notes that [REDACTED] had left behind.

Detective Sergeant Sessions told me that in his conclusion to this case he believed [REDACTED] harmed himself and that nobody else was involved in assisting with that. Detective Sergeant Sessions and I met with the executive board for Island View advising them of our findings.

I interviewed witnesses, student [REDACTED] and staff member David Ferrucci. All of their stories were consistent with each other.

I talked with the medical examiner's office and they confirmed the cause of death as suicide.

NARRATIVE:

On July 1, 2004 at 1846 hours, I was called by Davis County dispatch to respond to Island View Treatment Center, 2651 West 2700 South on a report of an attempted suicide.

I arrived at the main building and was met at the front doors by Sergeant Tracy Jensen.

He escorted me into the staff area and told me the victim was on his way to the hospital. He then told me that the crime scene was to the hall to our left.

Sergeant Jensen went with me down the hall in which I observed many books, chairs, and other miscellaneous items on the hall floor.

I brought in rubber gloves and a digital camera, etc., to process the crime scene.

I first took a picture #1, which shows door to the restroom from the hall. The restroom is where I was told the incident had occurred.

I took picture #2 of the bathroom door opened, showing items used by medical staff. Picture #3 shows entering the restroom area with other medical paraphernalia used by the medical staff. Picture #4 shows inside the restroom area along with the entrance door to the bathroom from the room where [REDACTED] lived. Picture #5 shows the bathroom stalls with the belt still attached used by the victim for the suicide. Picture #6 is a closer picture of the same area but shows also the leg of the chair that was used. Picture #7 shows another shot of the same. Picture #8 shows the chair and belt in the approximate area where used. Picture #9 is a picture of the same crime scene. Picture #10 shows some shoe marks in front of the stall, what I believed were from staff member, Chris Vowles attempting to get into the stall. Picture #11 is one of the letters written by [REDACTED] about some problems he had at the school. Picture #12 is a bag of personal effects.

After taking the pictures, myself and Sergeant Jensen looked through [REDACTED] personal letters, to look for a suicide note. We were unable to find any outright suicide notes.

There were several notes which indicated his frustration with his stay at Island View.

I left Sergeant Jensen and contacted Detective Heath Rogers to respond with the video camera. When I left I went into interview [REDACTED] (aka [REDACTED]).

I asked [REDACTED] to tell me what had happened in reference to the suicide today involving [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that he is what Island View staff calls a, "trail boss". [REDACTED] says that he has a list of sixteen males he is in charge of making sure when they go to assemblies, meetings or meals that he is to make sure all sixteen are accounted for.

This evening nine of the individuals were to be in line to go to dinner. Those individuals were: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The other seven had their rights taken away from them and were to sit in the hall for at least 18 hours a day. They ate their meals and did their assignments while in the hall. That accounts for the other seven students, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that the nine students were in the group room watching a movie

when [REDACTED] left approximately 45 minutes earlier from the time he had been found in the bathroom by [REDACTED]

Apparently [REDACTED] had left the movie, gone into the hall where the other seven students were and took a plastic fork and was flipping it from his mouth and bothering those students.

He was told by staff member, John Holland, not to bother the students in the hall and go to his group and sit at his desk until dinner.

He was observed by those seven students and John going into his room at approximately 6:15 p.m..

There is a door from [REDACTED] room into the restroom. Apparently [REDACTED] took his white plastic chair into the restroom, took his black belt and put it around the top railing of the larger restroom stall, put it around his neck and stepped off of the chair, causing his death.

I asked [REDACTED] to go through the events of the day. [REDACTED] stated that as they were standing in line to go to dinner he noticed that [REDACTED] was missing. [REDACTED] stated that it was not unusual for [REDACTED] to be the last one in line and [REDACTED] would go to the restroom for 30 to 40 minutes at a time. [REDACTED] stated he went to the restroom, opened the door and hollered for [REDACTED] but there was no response. [REDACTED] then checked [REDACTED] room, but could not see him. [REDACTED] asked the students in the hall, where [REDACTED] was and they stated he was at his desk. [REDACTED] had just checked there and knew he was not in his room. [REDACTED] then asked John Holland (staff member), if he could go into the restroom to check for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that John authorized him to go into the restroom. [REDACTED] went into the restroom and noticed legs hanging down below the door of the restroom stall and recognized the pants as [REDACTED]. Eddie also noticed a belt hanging down from the top rail. [REDACTED] stated he hollered at [REDACTED] and asked him, "What the fuck are you doing?" There was no response by Ian so [REDACTED] ran out into the hall and said, "The brother is trying to hang himself."

Chris Vowles (staff member), was just walking by and ran into the restroom, he was followed by David Ferrucci (staff member). [REDACTED] stated that Chris went under the stall because the bathroom stall door was locked and David went into the smaller stall next to the one [REDACTED] was hanging from and Chris lifted Ian up while David took the belt off of [REDACTED] neck.

John Holland (staff member), came in and told [REDACTED] to go ahead and go back to his room. [REDACTED] stated he complied and went to his room.

I asked [REDACTED] how [REDACTED] had acted today. He stated that [REDACTED] had been very upbeat, which was not normal for him, but thought he was just having a good day.

I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had any problems in the past that he knew of. He stated that about a month and a half ago [REDACTED] had wrote a poem and was put on suicide watch.

[REDACTED] stated that when all the students were brought back together, [REDACTED] told everyone in the group that he felt it was his fault because [REDACTED] had used his belt.

I asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had any problems with [REDACTED] being a roommate of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he knew of no problems between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had only been a roommate of [REDACTED] for approximately two days.

I then had Eddie write a witness statement.

I then had [REDACTED] brought into the room by staff members. I interviewed [REDACTED]. I asked him to tell me what had gone on today. [REDACTED] stated that he is, "On yellow zone today", this meant that he had to stay in the hall on a chair for 18 hours of the day and read books.

[REDACTED] stated that he last saw [REDACTED] in the hall around 5:45 p.m.. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had stuck a plastic fork up his nose and David told [REDACTED] to go sit

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at his desk. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] walked into our room and that was the last time he saw [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said he observed [REDACTED] hollering for [REDACTED] at the restroom and then asking David if he could check the north side bathroom and David told [REDACTED] to go ahead.

[REDACTED] said [REDACTED] went into the bathroom and came back approximately 10 seconds later and said the brother had hung himself.

David told us to go to our rooms and I went in to my room and was wondering what [REDACTED] could of hung himself with and noticed that his two belts were missing from his personal property. He described the two belts and neither matched the description of the belt I had observed.

I asked [REDACTED] "Why did you tell everybody that it was your fault that [REDACTED] had died?" He again stated, that because his belts were missing and a staff member came out of the restroom and told everyone that [REDACTED] did not have a pulse and it did not look good.

I asked [REDACTED] if he would be willing to take off his shirt so I could check for any scratches or bruises that may have been inflicted due to an altercation with [REDACTED]. I explained to [REDACTED] the necessity of this request, that it would also help clear him from any allegations since he had said that it was his fault that [REDACTED] had died.

[REDACTED] complied and there were no signs of any scratches or bruising on [REDACTED]

After concluding with this interview I met with Sergeant Jensen, Corporal Rogich and Detective Rogers in the hall. I told them that my investigation would lead me to believe that this was a self inflicted suicide. I asked if anyone else had any questions or concerns with the case and none were brought out.

I then went in to the staff area and met with Island View President, Lorin Broadbent and asked him if he would like to get his staff together so I could go over the case with them.

I met in the conference room with, Lorin Broadbent-President of Island View, Jared Balmer-Executive Director, Rick Jackson-Medical Director, Gay Jackson-Associated Executive Director, Steve Lancaster-Director of Mileu Therapy, Colleen Allie-Therapist, Dan Stuart-Director of Therapeutic Services, Dale Erdman-Therapist and Kimball DeLeMare-Director of Public Relations.

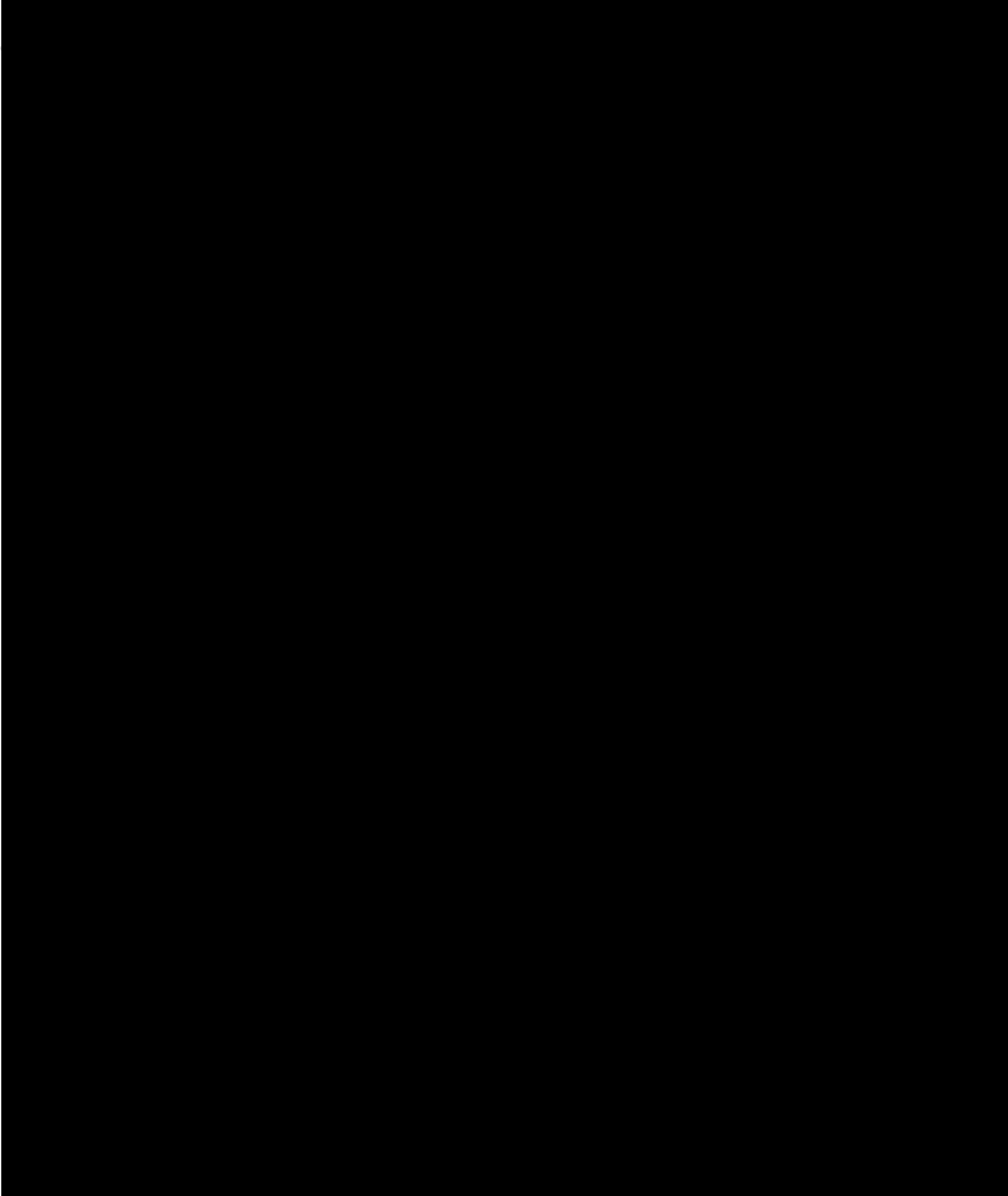
I advised them of the conclusion of my investigation and asked if there was any questions. Mr. Broadbent asked what they should do with [REDACTED] medical records that were kept in a folder? We all came up with a solution, because of HIPPA regulations that I could not review his folder without [REDACTED] parents consent. I did not want to bother [REDACTED] parents, so I went out to my patrol vehicle and I picked up a large plastic bag, put the folder inside, sealed it and gave it to Rick Jackson.

On July 2, 2004, I came back to the office and wrote an official statement with my preliminary findings and took it to Mike Moyes-City Administrator for review. I then took the letter and gave it to Lorin Broadbent at Island View.

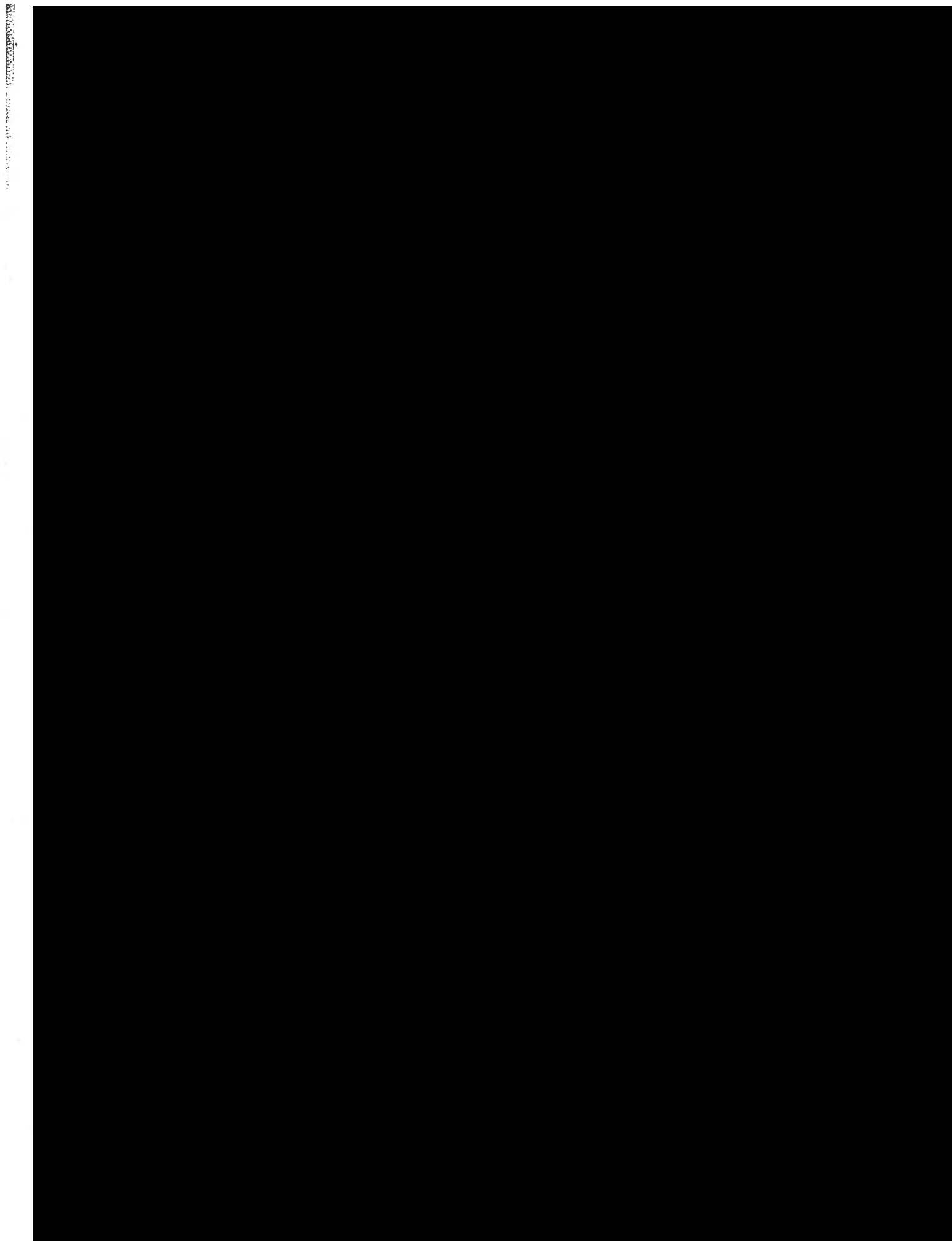
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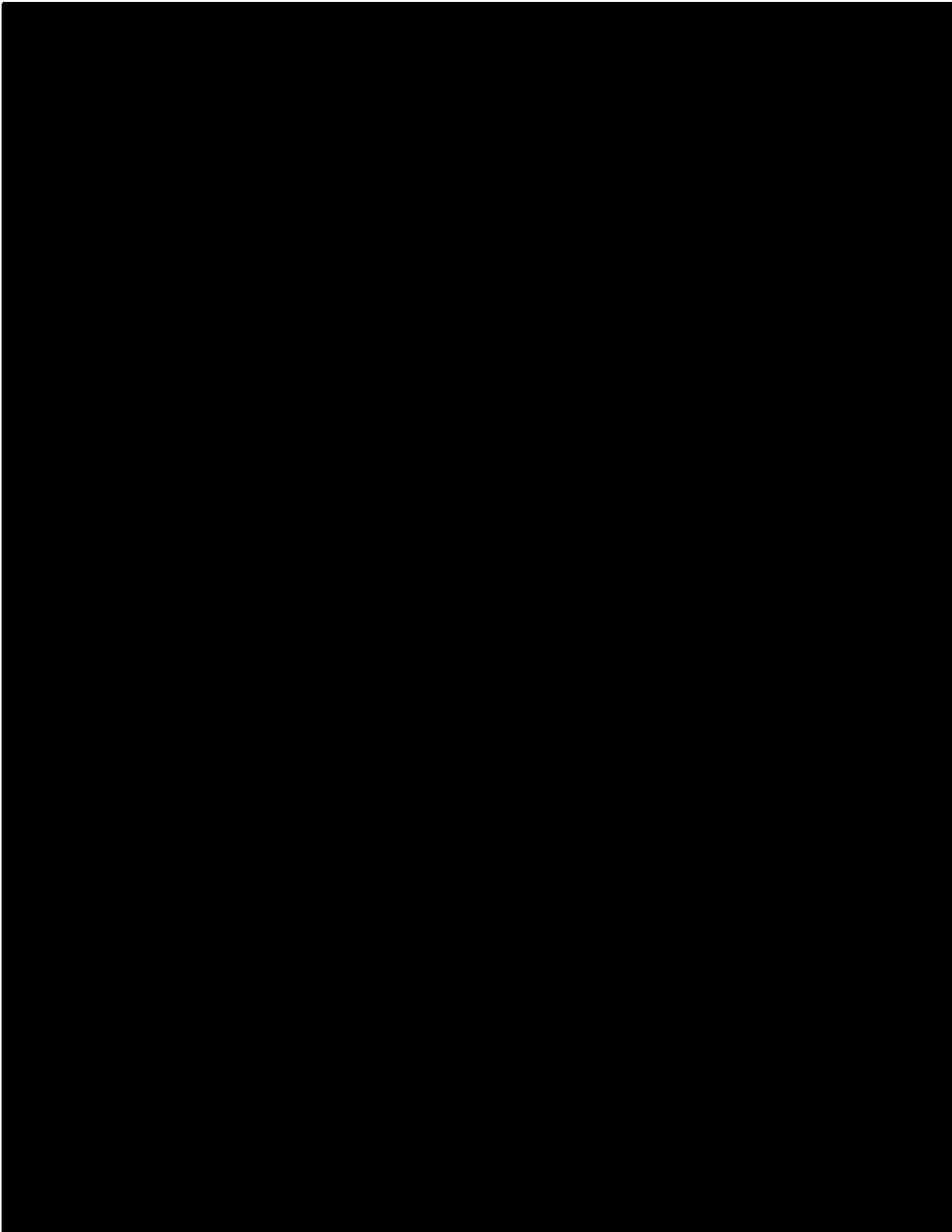
