please do not send your children here. I am about to be 19 and still remember the horrific events that I went through when I was seven years old and was held there for 15 months. The staff do not care about the children. They miss treat them. There are always numerous lice outbreaks. They will put your children in physical holds until they throw up. They will inject a medicine that they describe to us A turkey baster, because of how big the needle is. They will make fun of your children instead of helping them. And they will also let other kids pick on them, no matter how much older they are. When I was there, a staff even put me in a thing, called a chicken wing and bent my arm all the way back to the top of my back. Again, they do not care about the well-being of a child. They care about a payday and they do not care how they get it. all of the things that I've listed are all of the things that I experience there being a seven year old little girl. I am still deeply affected by this to this day, and it lives rent free in my mind, not to mention, while I was there, a male staff tried to pursue me and let me say it again while I was a little seven year old girl. If you really need to send your kid to a residential. Please send them anywhere other than here a good residential that I would recommend would be the village net work where I was brought when I was 16 years old and was treated like an actual decent human being. This isn't a place for kids to get help it's a place for kids to grow an extensive amount of trauma on top of everything that they're already going through. If you think that your kids behavioral problems, mental health problems or any other underlying issues are bad wait till you send them here and then see how they react afterwards. They will resent you. Please do not send children here no matter how old.

The things I have witnessed and the things I have physically gone through. From being locked in my room with six staff OFF cameras and stripped then put in a physical hold. My neck being pressed against the bedframe and I couldn't breathe the next day I had red dots all over my face. I've witnessed girls sit there and just absolutely tear themselves up when they self harm, puddles of blood at the end of hallway that just sat there. If you went down there and look close you can still see dried blood in the crevices of the floorboards. They fist fight a lot so your kid could be jumped by multiple other peers. The staff hold you down and give you a shot that puts you to sleep. I've watched grown men swing around the tiny 6 year olds on the dreams unit. This is not even half of it but please if you have any sympathy for your child then I highly recommend you not send them here and caseworkers please investigate before just sending a child to these abusive facilities they definitely don't deserve this treatment just because you failed to do a little research. DO BETTER PEOPLE.

I was in this placement twice as a kid. I hesitated on writing a review because there were a handful of staff members who are truly incredible people and if it weren't for them I don't know if I'd be alive. Plus its been a long time but based on recent reviews it doesnt sound like many changes have been made. I was put in a physical restraint for chewing on a spoon. It was my way of coping and we didn't have the luxury of gum. The food was honestly awful and they didn't give you alot espically because they put you on diets I was around 140 pounds the second time I went. I was recovering from a eating disorder and I was put on a diet. The first time I was tiny and was not put on one and was forced to eat. There was a kid like I'm talking maybe 7 years old who had two broken arms back to back not sure what happened as I was on the hopes unit not dreams but to me now as a parent there's no excuse for that. To the parents saying they can't talk to their kids you only get two 5 min phone calls a week at scheduled times. Again this was when I was there. I was from out of state (did not live in Ohio) and my parents couldn't afford to come see me every visitation and I didn't get extra phone calls to make up for it. The other kids are also a threat to those who aren't big and bad which isn't staffs fault but it did make it difficult to feel safe. I remember us girls sharing razor blades and staff wasn't really around to even find out. Eventually they found out and took care of it but it was all said and done. Just a lot happened so be careful and use this place as a last resort.. atleast if it hasn't changed

This is definitely a behavioral facility and not for mental health. The therapist make you feel like everything is your fault despite trauma you have been through. They rarely let you call home. If one person in the unit does something wrong everyone is punished for it. We went without tv and a radio for weeks because of one resident who was destructive. I had to lock me and another girl in the laundry room for over an hour because there was another girl who was trying to hurt the girl and she was much smaller and the staff did absolutely nothing. They don't take your concerns seriously. One girl would go and hit people randomly. I was concerned for my safety the whole time I was there which drew me away from actually bettering my mental health and getting better.

I was there in February till May so three months. While I was there I got beat up by a gang of girls on my unit in the lunch room. No staff intervened and I got a concussion. After repeatedly complaining from my family they finally decided to get me checked. The hospital they took me too was not good. It was an emergency room and they didn't clean the room I was in and it seemed like it was a closet that's how small it was. I then got moved from the group of girls when my family continued to complain. I got moved to the visions unit. That is where the girls with lower IQs were. They were constantly fighting and yelling and in no way was that helpful for my recovery. Many of them were keeping and hiding things to cut with and were sharing them. I was moved back after I was hit and they were trying to fight me. I was put on the dreams unit which has all the little children and I did nothing there. Once I was back in the right unit I was petrified of getting ganged up on again. I didn't get out of there until I begged and pleaded with my family. The food was horrible everyone was on "special" diets and you couldn't have seconds. No sharing food either. So a lot of the time I was hungry. It only helped me because I'm too afraid to try and kill myself because I don't wanna go back.

I went to this place three times for refusing to go to school because I was being bullied, among a few other minor issues I had as a troubled child. All three times I was heavily mistreated by the staff members, and I never got the help I needed. If I said I wasn't feeling well, I was called a liar. They finally took me seriously when I had a fever of 104.7°F and the nurses thought it was wise to pack me with ice instead of sending me to the hospital. They overdosed me on all my medications until I was having seizures in Gym. I was 10, 11, and 12 years old all three times I went there. I'm 18 years old now. I still have PTSD from that place, and I still have mental and physical issues because of the medications they put me on. I would not suggest putting your child or teenager here. The favouritism is atrocious, the food is unhealthy, and the treatment alone is enough to send you spiralling into insanity.

Two of the three times I went there, bed bugs were a major issue. Other patients at the facility would attack me without warning or reason. The staff would watch me use the bathroom and take a shower because I'd "take too long". My privacy was often violated by the staff members when it came to bathroom breaks and shower time. I've had staff members take away my belongings that I still haven't gotten returned to me to this day. Staff members who didn't like me would exaggerate my behaviours. For example; one of the patients there had pushed me while I was in line for breakfast. I pushed her back because she was right up against me and wouldn't back off (the staff wouldn't intervene and do anything about it), but the staff memeber in charge at the time claimed I had HIT the patient. This place is a nightmare, and like I said; I still suffer from my experiences there.
