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considerable acreage, administration offices, school, dining hall, shower/laundry facilities, gymnasium and recreation facilities. The setting itself is the foundation for an environment where adolescents experiencing emotional and behavioral difficulties can safely begin to discover their hidden potential by learning about their personal strengths.

The Outdoor Therapeutic Programs utilize the group process model which helps adolescents work towards solutions to daily problems. The emphasis is on goal setting and achieving positive thinking and redirection. Each program has a private school located on campus, which is appropriately licensed and many programs are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools or the Mid-Atlantic Association of Colleges and Schools or the Georgia Schools Accrediting Commission.
