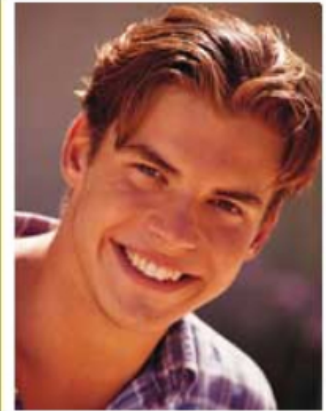

Outdoor Therapeutic - Typical Day

An OTP group wakes up by 6:30 a.m. Your child will clean their personal area and the campsite, then perform an assigned task to help keep the group site in proper order and ensure that adequate supplies are on hand. These tasks must be completed before the group is able to leave the campsite. Afterwards the group goes to the main campus dining hall, where all groups meet for each daily meal.

After breakfast, groups participate in a variety of activities that are scheduled by the group members themselves. School, showers, laundry, personal hygiene and nightly group meetings are scheduled, as are vocational projects, group and individual goal setting, adventure therapy, recreation and free time. Specialty groups meet once or twice a week for students with issues concerning alcohol and drug abuse or sexual abuse.



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
