PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

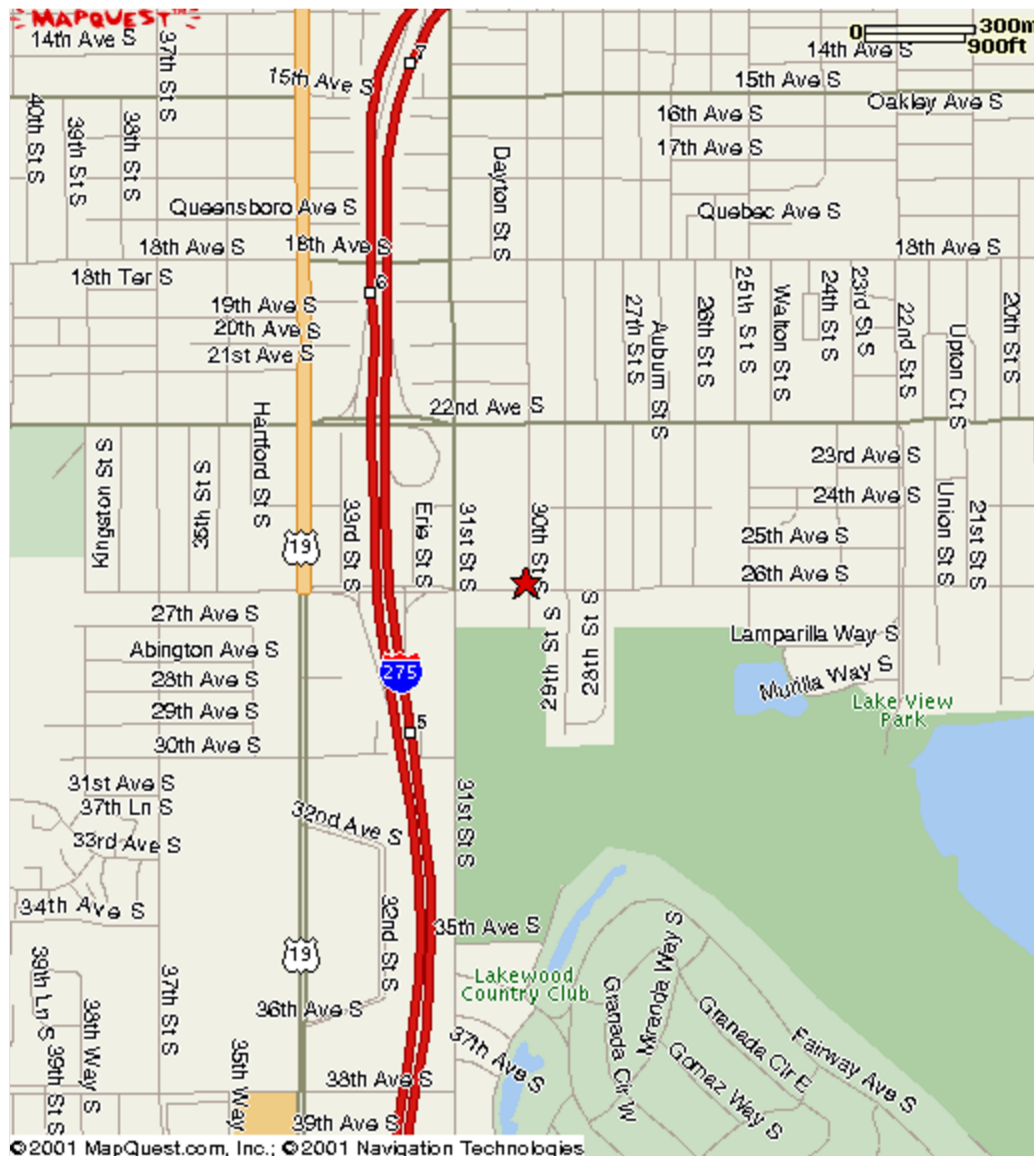

Youth attend in-house or public school, or obtain employment. Average length of stay is 4-6 months. Program provides uniforms. Offenders should bring their own shoes and underwear.
